To Our Residents and Family Members:

We want to keep you updated on the status of the coronavirus. We currently have no new confirmed COVID-19 cases associated with residents or staff in our facility. We still are under the order from the State that only essential medical or delivery personnel are allowed into the building. Our current order specifies that we should restrict residents to their rooms as much as possible. We recognize that this can lead to feelings of loneliness and depression. Our activity department is working to combat this by having door to door activities daily. We have purchased TV trays so that the residents can sit at their doorway while we have some "hallway" activities. We are piloting a program using Alexa so that our resident can play music and games and listen to the weather. We are delivering snacks and a variety of puzzles and games to the residents in their apartments.

As an assisted living facility in Colorado, we continue to be under the Stay at Home order by the Governor. We also are following the local health department and CDC guidelines which recommend that residents stay in the facility not just for their own health, but for the protection of all the other residents and staff. This means that although businesses are beginning to open, only essential destinations – grocery stores, medical appointments or going for a walk are on the approved list for our residents to go. Should residents choose to attend a non-essential function such as going home with family or going to a non-essential business such as a beauty salon we will need to have them quarantine in their apartment upon return to The Argyle for 2 weeks so that we can monitor their symptoms before they interact with other residents.

The health department has put into place an order for residents to wear face coverings in the building when they are out of their apartments. Masks should be worn also when going to essential places or interacting with others.
