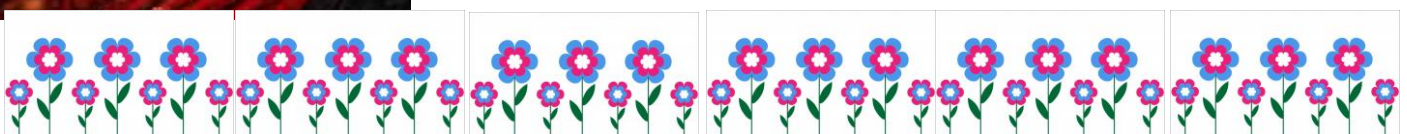


WELCOME SPRING

May 30th Memorial Day- Memorial Day is an American holiday, observed on the last Monday of May, honoring the men and women who died while serving in the U.S. military.

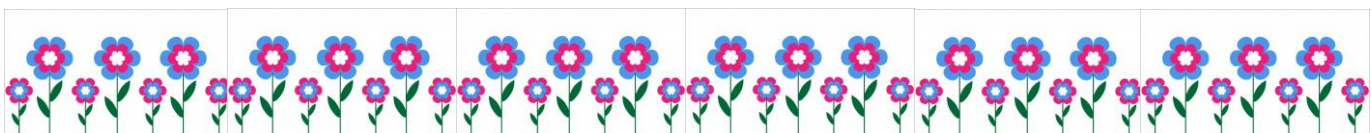
