UPCOMING EVENTS/HOLIDAYS

June 14th Flag Day – In the United States, Flag Day is celebrated on June 14. It commemorates the adoption of the flag of the United States on June 14, 1777, by resolution of the Second Continental Congress.

June 18th Father's Day – Happy Father's Day- The first-ever Father's Day was celebrated on June 19, 1910 in Washington state, although it was not named a national holiday until President Richard Nixon signed it into law in 1972.

June 19th Juneteenth – Juneteenth is a federal holiday in the United States commemorating the emancipation of enslaved African Americans. It is celebrated on the anniversary of the order, issued by Major General Gordon Granger on June 19, 1865. This day was first recognized as a federal holiday in 2021 by President Joe Biden.

June 21st Summer Begins – Summer is the hottest of the four temperate seasons, occurring after Spring and before Autumn. At or centered on the summer solstice, the earliest sunrise and latest sunset occurs, daylight hours are longest and dark hours are shortest.

This being said, the Colorado Department of Public Health has extended Coronavirus precautions as their permanent standard. Please wear a mask if you are feeling ill. A friendly reminder that smoking is only permitted in the smoking area. The smoking area is located at the end of the Gardens hallway at the north east corner of the block. Smoking anywhere else within a six-foot radius of Argyle grounds is prohibited. For questions regarding the smoking area please contact John Sliz, Director of Environmental Services.

The security system at the Argyle is currently being upgraded. The new nurse call system is in full function. New high-resolution cameras will be installed throughout the community. Finally, access control doors will be installed both to enter and exit the community, as well as resident rooms.

Q- Do residents have air conditioning in their rooms?

A- Yes, all resident rooms are equipped with vents for air flow. For questions on air conditioning, please contact John Sliz, Director of Environmental Services.

Q- Will the Argyle be providing shade for the smoking area?

A- No, the Argyle will not be providing shade for the smoking area. For questions regarding the smoking area, please contact John Sliz.

Q- Why was the first-floor balcony locked?

A- The first-floor balcony was locked due to the growing number of residents smoking on this balcony. This balcony will remain locked until further notice. With questions regarding balcony access, please contact John Sliz.

Q- Does the Argyle have overnight security?

A- No, the Argyle has never had overnight security. There are however, a minimum of three staff members on site, overnight, at all times. With questions regarding overnight staff, please contact Lesha Duran, Resident Life Director.

Q- When a resident presses their pendant at night, who gets the notification?

A- All onsite overnight staff receive the page. The first available caregiver or QMAP will respond to the call. For questions pertaining to pendant pages, please contact Lesha Duran.

Q- Will the common area bathrooms return after the remodel?

A- Yes, all common area bathrooms will be replaced as bathrooms with the remodel. For questions about the remodel, please contact John Sliz.

Q- When will the Argyle be getting a vending machine?

A- The Argyle is currently in the process of vetting vendors for on-site vending machines. For information about vending machines, please contact Becky Trujillo, Director of Dining Services.
