Scenic Escape to Evergreen Lake

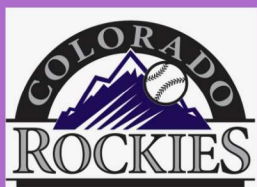
Join us for a relaxing day surrounded by mountain beauty as we take a scenic drive up to Evergreen Lake on Tuesday, May 27th.
