The name October comes from the Latin "octo", meaning eight, since it was the eighth month in the early Roman calendar.

October birthdays are either Libra (Sept 23–Oct 22), known for balance, or Scorpio (Oct 23–Nov 21), known for passion.

October's birthstones are the opal (hope and love) and the tourmaline (protection and healing).

Breast Cancer Awareness Month is observed in October, promoting research, support, and prevention. Pink ribbons are worn worldwide as a symbol of hope and awareness. The Hunter's Moon appears

in October, named for the hunting season before winter.

On October 1, 1971, Walt Disney World opened in Orlando, Florida.

Famous October birthdays include Mahatma Gandhi (Oct 2), Eleanor Roosevelt (Oct 11), Pablo Picasso (Oct 25), and Theodore Roosevelt (Oct 27).

Q: How will the door to the smoking patio work?

A: The new smoking patio door will soon lock automatically. Residents can use their key fob to re-enter. Residents will need their key fob 24/7. If you forget your fob, pull the cord to alert staff. Please don't let in unknown individuals—visitors must enter through the front doors on 38th Ave.

Q: How can I keep my apartment warm this fall?

A: Close your windows when it's cold outside. The hot water heating system will maintain the temperature you set but takes time to adjust. If you need help with your windows or thermostat, ask a caregiver.

Q: Should staff knock before entering apartments?

A: Yes—staff should always knock and wait for acknowledgment before entering. If you've pressed your pendant for help, they will knock but may enter right away.

Anderson Farm Pumpkin Patch

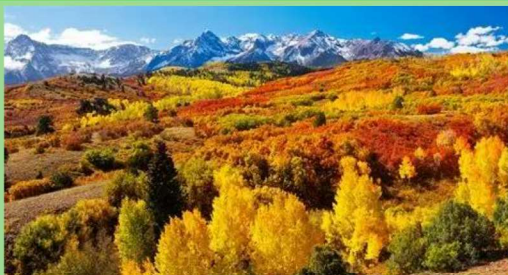
