🍺🎶 Come enjoy brats and beer, clap along to polka favorites, and show off your best Chicken Dance moves!



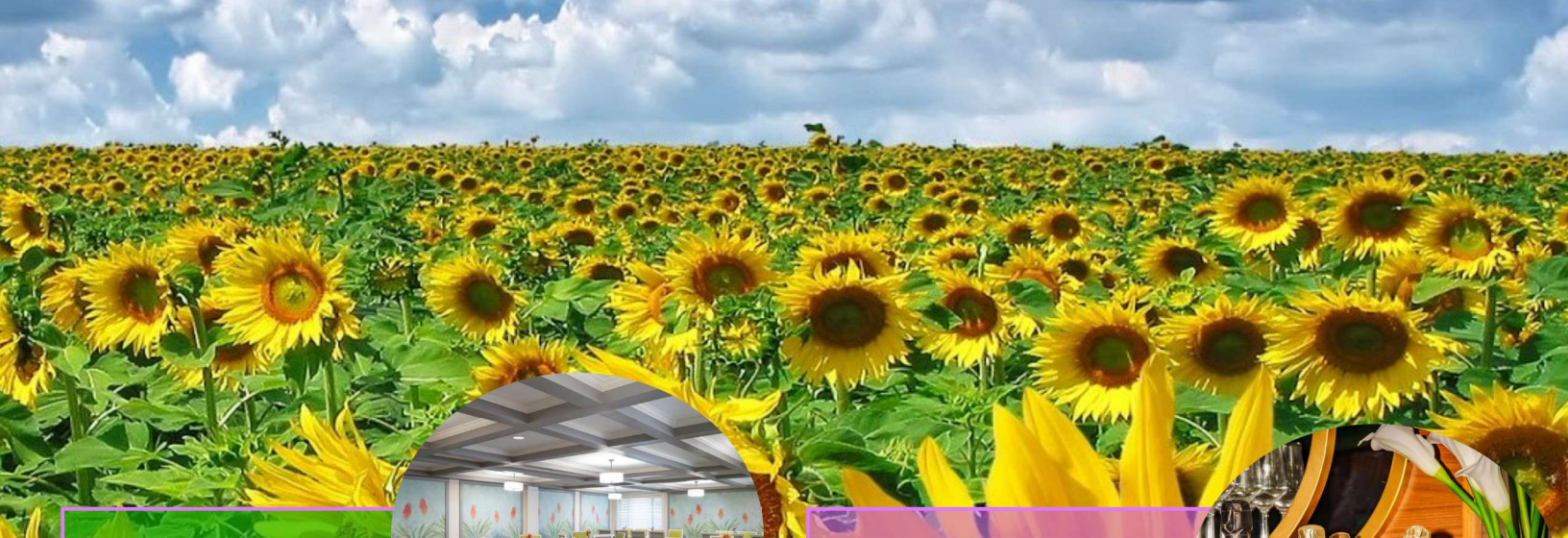
Hispanic Heritage Month is celebrated from September 15th to October 15th. This month honors the histories, cultures, and contributions of Americans whose ancestors came from Spain, Mexico, the Caribbean, and Central and South America. The celebration begins on September 15th, the anniversary of independence for Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua. Mexico and Chile also celebrate their independence days on September 16th and 18th. Throughout the month, communities highlight traditions through music, dance, food, and storytelling that showcase the richness of Hispanic heritage.

September marks the start of autumn in the Northern Hemisphere, with the autumnal equinox usually falling between September 22–23, when day and night are nearly equal.

Famous September birthdays include Beyoncé (Sep 4), Freddie Mercury (Sep 5), Agatha Christie (Sep 15), and Bruce Springsteen (Sep 23).

On September 2, 1945, World War II officially ended when Japan formally surrendered.

The Harvest Moon often appears in September, the full moon closest to the autumn equinox, helping farmers work late.

### Monthly Resident Meeting

Q: What happens when a resident sign up for an outing and then cancel at the last minute?

A: If there is a cost to the outing that was pre-paid by The Argyle and no one on the wait list takes their spot the resident may be charged, with the acceptance of medical reasons, etc.

## Last Rockies Game of the Year



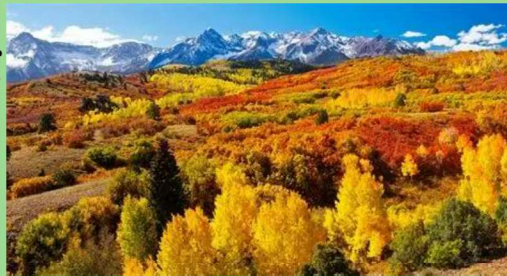
