December Facts!

The name December comes from the Latin “decem,” meaning ten, as it was the tenth month in the early Roman calendar.

December birthdays fall under Sagittarius (Nov 22–Dec 21), known for optimism and curiosity, or Capricorn (Dec 22–Jan 19), known for discipline and practicality.

December's birthstones are turquoise (symbolizing protection and good fortune), tanzanite (representing transformation), and zircon (associated with wisdom and clarity).

Hanukkah, Christmas, and Kwanzaa are all celebrated in December, making it one of the most festive and culturally rich months of the year.

The Cold Moon rises in December, named for the frigid, long nights of the winter season.

On December 7, 1941, the attack on Pearl Harbor took place, a pivotal moment in U.S. history that led to the country entering World War II.

Famous December birthdays include Walt Disney (Dec 5), Jane Austen (Dec 16), Ludwig van Beethoven (Dec 17), and Denzel Washington (Dec 28).
