Please note that seating is limited and expected to fill quickly. Each reservation will hold your table for one hour. If you arrive 30 minutes late, your remaining dining time will be adjusted accordingly so we can accommodate all families.

Here are a few highlights from our March Resident Town Meeting:

Q: When will we have a new Resident Care Director?

A: We're excited to share that Holly Guzman has been promoted to this role! She will be transitioning gradually from her current position as Resident Care Manager into her new role, ensuring a smooth and thoughtful handoff. In the meantime, we will be actively recruiting for her replacement.

Q: Where can I smoke and what are the hours?

A: Smoking is permitted only for residents who moved in prior to November 1, 2025. The designated smoking area is the North Patio, which is monitored by camera and supported by our front desk team.

The North Patio is open for smoking from 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM. If you wish to smoke outside of these hours, you will need to leave the community, as smoking is not permitted anywhere on campus after hours. For safety reasons, smoking is also not allowed in the streets.

Your safety and well-being are always our top priorities—thank you for helping us maintain a safe environment for everyone.

Q: When will the parking lot remodel take place?

A: We have received four bids for the parking lot renovation and are aiming to begin the project this spring, though a start date has not yet been finalized. As soon as we have a confirmed timeline, we will share a detailed update with residents.

The new parking lot will feature concrete surfacing along with fresh striping for improved organization and safety. As a reminder, the front parking lot is reserved for visitors. Residents are encouraged to park on the east side of the north parking lot or along the street.
