Q: When can I sign up for outings?

That timing may vary slightly depending on the weather, as we want to ensure your comfort during both warm days and cooler nights. We appreciate your patience as we transition into the warmer season!

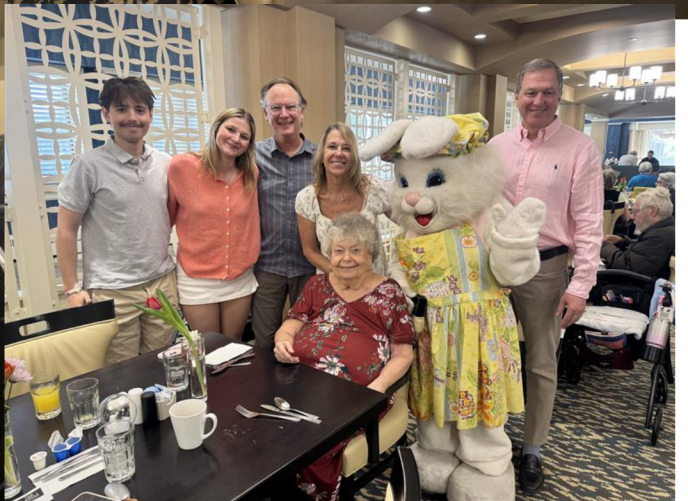
